

## Entries Are Limited to 200 Riders

If it is necessary to limit entries, the following preferences apply:

1. Residents of Region 12 who own a registered Arabian or HA/AA.
2. Sibling of #1 with a non-Arabian horse.
3. Barn Pal of # 1 with a non-Arabian horse.
4. Resident of Region 12 with a Non-Arabian Horse.
5. Non-Residents of Region 12 as above.

## Arrival Information & Stabling

Stalls will be available at Noon on Tuesday,  
And must be vacated by midnight on Sunday.

Early arrival or late departure may be arranged for an additional fee.

Stop at the entrance tent for stall  
information from noon to 6:00 pm.

## Shavings

Shavings must be ordered directly from Queen Wood Products,  
Mr. Rob Robbins at 770-860-9111 or cell 678-416-1424.

The facility requires a minimum of two bales per horse stall.  
Please order by 2:00 pm for same-day delivery by 6:00 pm.

Queen Wood Products also rents Golf Carts at the show.

If you pre-ordered shavings, they will be waiting at your stalls.

Shavings can NOT be charged to your show tab.

You may bring your own shavings to the show,  
But you are not allowed to sell any shavings.
